- King County has a 24/7 response team for any behavior health crisis
- Based on ETA of response team, this is more for "frequent flyers" or anyone that needs extra resource other than hospital.
 - o Patient needs to be over 18, no immediate medical need, and voluntarily agrees to participate
- King County has opened up its CIT program to all first responders. 8 hour and 72 hour courses available.
 - o Multiple meeting attendees have had their department members attend and have reported nothing but positive things. "Best class I've ever been", one said.

Tracie Griego: King County EMS tracie.griego@kingcounty.gov

- Wants to say thank you for continuing to upload your cardiac events, but based on available resources, if you want a case review, email her directly.
- She is asking all departments to keep 5 to 10 percent of your annual calls worth of hard copy MIRF's just in case something goes wrong. Also, if your department has extra MIRF's that you do not need, send them back. She is beginning the purchase order for next year.
- If your department is planning to order the Phillip FR3's, please budget for the puck. The puck does not come with, and that is what allows all of the information to be downloaded.
- Version 5 of Phillips software only works on windows ten, while version 4 does not.
